

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF A 1980 MACK CF-686FCA LADDER TRUCK KNOWN AS BUDD LAKE LADDER 58 TO THE TOWNSHIP OF BLAIRSTOWN, COUNTY OF WARREN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, the Budd Lake Fire Department owns a 1980 Mack CF-686FCA ladder truck known as Ladder 58 bearing VIN# xxxxxxxx1373; and

WHEREAS, a new ladder truck for the Budd Lake Fire Department has been constructed such that there will be no further public use of Ladder 58; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Olive and the Budd Lake Fire Department now wishes to sell Ladder 58, which is public property; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Olive, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-36, may by Resolution and without advertising for bids, sell its personal property to any governmental unit in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Blairstown is a municipal entity located in the County of Warren, State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Blairstown, pursuant to authorization by its Township Committee, has provided the Township of Mount Olive with a letter of intent, dated December 23, 2013, to purchase the 1980 Mack Ladder Truck, known as Ladder 58, for the purchase price of \$10,000; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council has previously indicated that it would be acceptable for any proceeds from any sale of Ladder 58 to be forwarded to Budd Lake Fire Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that the Township of Mount Olive is authorized to sell Ladder 58 bearing VIN# xxxxxxxx1373 to the Township of Blairstown, County of Warren, State of New Jersey for the purchase price of \$10,000 in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-36 with the proceeds of the sale going directly to the Budd Lake Fire Department and not the Township of Mount Olive.
