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





Governor Christie's Sandy recovery office, the Federal Hurricane Sandy Rebuilding Task Force, FEMA and the NJ Office of Emergency Management to provide opening remarks and to participate in a facilitated discussion with Together North Jersey members and stakeholders. The discussion will focus on identifying issues, needs and priorities in the six Recovery Support Function areas that are part of FEMA's National Disaster Recovery Framework:

1. Community Planning and Capacity Building Recovery
2. Economic Recovery
3. Health and Social Services Recovery
4. Housing Recovery
5. Infrastructure Systems Recovery
6. Natural and Cultural Resources Recovery
