

Dear Mr. Spiegel:

This is in reference to a survey being conducted by the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) to inventory all Bus Stops along State and US Routes in New Jersey.

The staff of Jacobs Engineering has conducted a field survey for NJDOT. The following unapproved bus stop locations have been identified by New Jersey Transit (NJT) as "Inactive" according to information supplied by Jacobs Engineering. Since the written information provided by NJT indicates that these locations are inactive, the NJDOT must assume that NJT has no desire to legally establish bus stops at these locations and can take no further action at this time.

If NJT wishes to legally establish bus stops at any of these locations, the NJDOT Bureau of Traffic Engineering will require a formal request from your office including the results of New Jersey Transit's field investigation and a completed Municipal Review Statement from Mount Olive Township Officials prior to initiating any further action.

The subject bus stop locations are as follows:

Along Route US 46 westbound, on the northerly side thereof at:

1. Smithtown Road (near side) Transit ID # 25892  
Beginning at the easterly curblineline of Smithtown Road and extending 105 feet easterly therefrom.

Along Route US 46 eastbound, on the southerly side thereof at:

1. Manor House Road (near side) Transit ID # 25874  
Beginning at the prolongation of the westerly curblineline of Manor House Road and extending 105 feet westerly therefrom.
