

**Ord. #1-2009**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE  
REPEALING SECTION 178-4 ENTITLED “LOITERING;  
LOUD, OFFENSIVE OR INDECENT LANGUAGE” OF THE  
TOWNSHIP CODE**

WHEREAS, the Township has undergone a study as to the appropriateness of that section of the Code referred to as Section 178-4 entitled “Loitering; loud, offensive or indecent language” and has determined that it is appropriate to repeal that section, as there are other sections in the Township’s Code and State Statute that address that section and the term “loitering” is no longer a term appropriately utilized in the municipal criminal code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Section 178-4 entitled “Loitering; loud, offensive or indecent language” is hereby repealed.

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.
