ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY APPROPRIATING \$700,000 FOR THE ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY, SUCH APPROPRIATION CONSISTS OF A \$700,000 GREEN ACRES GRANT FROM THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. \$700,000 is hereby appropriated, all of which will be funded by a Green Acres Grant from the State of New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, for the acquisition of property known as West King Estates and more specifically described as Block 7702, Lots 1 and 2, Block 8100 Lot 61 and Block 8200 Lot 1 on the tax maps of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Township"), including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto.

Section 2. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by the law.
