

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT
OLIVE APPROVING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN
THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AND THE MOUNT OLIVE JUNIOR
LACROSSE CLUB INC. FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A LACROSSE FIELD
AS A SECTION OF DRAKESBROOK PARK**

WHEREAS, the Mount Olive Township Council and the Mount Olive Junior Lacrosse Club Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "MOJLC") Board of Directors and committees, after a thorough investigation and analysis have determined that the development of a Lacrosse field as a section of Drakesbrook Park will provide a significant and much needed catalyst for continuing development of youth Lacrosse programs with the Township of Mount Olive (hereinafter referred to as the "Township"), which will promote the use of funded parkland for recreation and conservation purposes; and

WHEREAS, it has always been understood between the Township and the MOJLC that the Lacrosse Field would be more than just a park but will be a significant development project that will greatly add to the needs of the rapidly growing youth Lacrosse segment of the Township as well as the prestige of the Township and the MOJLC, which, in turn, will promote the use of funded parkland for recreation and conservation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the MOJLC has agreed to fund all costs in connection with the planning and construction of the Lacrosse Field; and

WHEREAS, the Township shall bond for the cost of the construction for the Lacrosse Field and the MOJLC shall reimburse the Township as to such costs for the construction of the field.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mount Olive Township Council, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Mount Olive Township Council hereby approves the Memorandum of Understanding by and between the Township and the MOJLC, attached to this Resolution and made a part hereof, for the development of a Lacrosse Field as a section of Drakesbrook Park.
2. The Mount Olive Township Council hereby authorizes the Mayor of Mount Olive Township to execute, on behalf of the Township, the Memorandum of Understanding by and between the Township and the MOJLC.
3. The Memorandum of Understanding is subject to approval by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection/Green Acres.
