Municipal Notification – 2009 Vegetation and/or Other Routine Maintenance Activities



Dear Sir or Madam:

Pursuant to Special Condition #3 of the subject Permit, which was issued on June 21, 2005 and is valid through June 21, 2010, JCP&L is hereby providing notification of its intent to undertake vegetation and/or other routine maintenance activities that may occur within wetlands or wetland transition areas within your municipality. As also required by this Special Condition, JCP&L is hereby providing a street map showing the location of those transmission rights-of-way scheduled to be maintained in 2009 within your municipality.

The routes highlighted on the enclosed map depict the general location of transmission rights-of-way where vegetation and/or other routine maintenance activities are scheduled to be conducted in 2009. These activities may include manual and/or mechanical tree trimming, selective low volume stump or foliar application of herbicides, vegetation clearing and/or removal, transmission line re-conductorings, and pole/tower repair and/or replacement. These activities are being undertaken in an effort to reduce/eliminate power outages caused by vegetation interference with the Company's electrical system and to maintain the electrical system in good working order.

Vegetation and electrical system maintenance of the Company's distribution lines, primarily along streets and roads, may also be conducted to reduce power outages caused by storm damage and to protect public safety.

To the extent these maintenance activities may occur within wetlands or wetland transition areas, they are being conducted in accordance with the terms and conditions of the subject Wetlands General Permit #1.
