

Ord. #13-2013

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A YIELD SIGN AT THE INTERSECTION OF CARSON ROAD AND DELBAR DRIVE [TO BE INCORPORATED INTO CHAPTER 245 OF THE MOUNT OLIVE TOWNSHIP CODE]

WHEREAS, both the Mount Olive Township Police Department and the Township's Engineer have recommended the installation of a yield sign at the intersection of Carson Road and Delbar Drive for the safety of the Township's residents.

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-8, the Township Engineer has certified to the Township Council that he has investigated the traffic circumstances on the roadway in question, that it appears to the Engineer that it is in the best interests of the public safety and the expedition of traffic that the installation of a yield sign will conform to the standards of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways; and

WHEREAS, the section of the roadway in question is wholly contained in the Township of Mount Olive; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 39:4-197 authorizes the Township to pass, without the approval of the New Jersey Commissioner of Transportation, an ordinance regulating the passage or stopping of traffic at congested street corners or other designated points that are under the jurisdiction of the Township;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey as follows:

Chapter 245 of the Mount Olive Township Code entitled, "Vehicles and Traffic" is hereby amended to incorporate the following (the underscoring represents new language),

SECTION 1. Commencing May 1, 2013, a yield sign may be installed on Carson Road at its intersection with Delbar Drive.

SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portion of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance may be renumbered for purposes of codification.
