

Ord.#19 - 2014

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO AMEND CHAPTER 211, ARTICLE II, SECTION 211-15, ENTITLED "PLACEMENT OF MATERIAL FOR COLLECTION"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1.

Chapter 211, Article II, Section 211-15(A) of the Mount Olive Township Code entitled, "Placement of material for collection" currently provides as follows:

- A. No person shall leave for residential collection by the municipality more than three containers, receptacles or bags of solid waste, other than containers for recyclable items. No containers, receptacles or bags shall be of such volume or weight as to exceed 34 gallons or 40 pounds. This provision is waived for holiday collection on Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas.

This section is hereby amended to read as follows:

- A. No person shall leave for residential collection by the municipality:
 - 1. Solid Waste – No more than the one (1) 96 gallon or one (1) 65 gallon container provided by the municipality as part of its automated trash collection program.
 - 2. Recycling – Single stream recycling must be in containers, not to exceed 40 pounds. There is no limit on the amount of recycling containers.
 - 3. Recycling containers bearing the logo of the Township of Mount Olive and in a capacity of 65 gallons shall be available for sale by the Department of Public Works for \$50.00 per container. Proceeds will be dedicated to the Recreation Utility.

This provision is waived for holiday collection on Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas.

SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction,

such decision shall not affect the remaining portion of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance may be renumbered for purposes of codification.
