

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE
REQUESTING PERMISSION FOR THE DEDICATION BY RIDER
FOR DONATIONS – 911 MEMORIAL AT TURKEY BROOK PARK
REQUIRED BY NJSA 40A:5-29**

WHEREAS, permission is required of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services for approval as a dedication by rider of revenues received by a municipality when the revenue is not subject to reasonable accurate estimates in advance; and

WHEREAS, NJSA 40A:5-29 provides for receipt of donations – 911 Memorial at Turkey Brook Park by the municipality to provide for the operating costs to administer this act; and

WHEREAS NJSA 40A:4-39 provides the dedicates revenues anticipated from the Donations – 911 Memorial at Turkey Brook Park are hereby anticipated as revenue and are hereby appropriated for the purpose to which said revenue is dedicated by statute or other legal requirement.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the Township of Mount Olive in the County of Morris, New Jersey as follows:

1. The governing body does hereby request permission of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to pay expenditures of the Donations – 911 Memorial at Turkey Brook Park according to NJSA 40A:5-29.
2. The Clerk of the Township of Mount Olive, County of Morris, is hereby directed to forward two certified copies of this resolution to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
