

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE USE OF OPEN SPACE FUNDS FOR CLEARANCE OF OPEN SPACE HIKING TRAIL (WHITE TRAIL)

WHEREAS, Super storm Sandy caused much devastation to the Township of Mount Olive, its residents as well as its public property; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Olive has allocated open space and hiking trails for the enjoyment by the residents of the township and beyond; and

WHEREAS, through the townships efforts the “White Trail” portion from the Mount Olive High School area through Gold Mine Rd is close to being reopened; and

WHEREAS, there exist blockages of downed trees due to Super storm Sandy preventing the trails from being opened and enjoyed by the community; and

WHEREAS, there is an identified need to clear the trails for recreation use as soon as possible; and

WHEREAS, this is an allowable expense that can be covered by the open space trust fund and whereas there is funding in the Open Space Trust Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive that the following expenses are hereby authorized in connection with the trail clearing project from Flanders Road through Gold Mine Road portion of the White Trail.
