






AWEP Cost Share Announcement 2012

Funding Available to Local Farmers

Agricultural producers and land owners in Hunterdon, Morris and Somerset Counties may be eligible for federal funding for conservation practices that improve water quality through the Agricultural Water Enhancement Program (AWEP). Fundable practices include livestock access control fencing, composting, cover crops, nutrient management, prescribed grazing, pest management, gutters, stream crossings, waste storage facilities, and livestock watering facilities to name a few. Applicants must have an interest in an agricultural operation predominately located within the three designated sub-watersheds of the Raritan River Basin. Applicants must apply by March 18, 2012, for a share of New Jersey's 2012 AWEP allocation of \$249,000.

Twenty-two municipalities in Hunterdon, Morris and Somerset Counties are included in the program area. Property in parts of the Spruce Run/Mulhockaway Creek, the Neshanic River, and the South Branch/Long Valley watersheds may be eligible.
