

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING A NEW
911 MEMORIAL AT TURKEY BROOK PARK**

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Olive lost one of its citizens, Hilda Marcin, during the attacks on September 11, 2001; and

WHEREAS, memorial services have been held at the Municipal Complex and other places of worship over the past years; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Olive is desirous of having a 911 Memorial installed at Turkey Brook Park to honor those who lost their lives and celebrate the human spirit which evolved from that attack; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Olive has the All Veterans Memorial located at Turkey Brook Park where this memorial will be adjacent to; and

WHEREAS, Councilman Ray Perkins has been working with Councilman Joe Nicastro, his son Michael, the Township Special Projects Coordinator Lisa Pignataro, IT Director Scott Gaskill, and other volunteers to produce an photo example of the project; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that all funding for this project will be received from donations by large corporations, small businesses, local civic and religious groups, and the general public.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that it does hereby authorize a new 911 Memorial to be located at Turkey Brook Park adjacent to the All Veterans Memorial with the following elements:

1. Jet Black Polished Granite monument with etchings on a concrete pedestal.
2. Three Marble topped steps surrounding the front and sides of the memorial.
3. Four separate logos of the Township Fire, EMS, and Police in pavers.
4. Paver walkway for the monument.
5. Curved wall and landscaping at the back of the memorial.
