

The Department hereby approves the Remedial Action Work Plan for Permit By Rule, effective the date of this letter.

This New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System/Discharge to Ground Water (NJPDES/DGW) permit-by-rule discharge approval for a Pump and Treat system is hereby issued under the authority of the New Jersey Water Pollution Control Act, N.J.S.A. 58:10A-1 et seq. and the implementing regulations, N.J.A.C. 7:14A-1 et seq. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:14A-22.4(b)5, a Treatment Works Approval is not required for discharges to ground water authorized pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:14A-7.5(b) and contained in this letter. Be advised that the time period for the discharge begins on the day the discharge first occurs, not on the date the discharge approval letter is issued or received. Consistent with N.J.A.C. 7:14A-7.5(b)3 the approved discharge of treated ground water

via overland flow is to remediate contamination from discharges of heating oil as defined at N.J.A.C. 7:14A-1.2, at a residential building of four units or less.

Pursuant to the schedule applicable to the site you shall submit a Remedial Action (Progress) Report on August 31, 2012. Please submit the document by that date, or submit a written request for an extension at least 2 weeks prior to the due date. Failure to submit the [document type] in accordance with the schedule may result in the initiation of enforcement action.
