**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE
REACTIVATING FLANDERS NETCONG ROAD TO
GOLD MINE ROAD**

WHEREAS, the Township in 2000, in light of the development of the Trade Zone South as a major commercial mall determined that a traffic circulation pattern which would permit traffic to flow from Route 206 down Gold Mine Road and then down Flanders Netcong Road or in reverse, because of the established and growing residential nature of Flanders Netcong Road; and

WHEREAS, in order to prevent Flanders Netcong Road from being a through street to and from Gold Mine Road, the Township Council adopted Ordinance 31-2000 that vacated a 10 foot width of Flanders Netcong Road between a point 490 feet south of its intersection with Gold Mine Road and a point 500 feet south of its intersection with Gold Mine Road; and

WHEREAS, the Township Public Safety Committee voted unanimously to re-open this road and agreed there is a public safety issue having this road closed, all agreeing that Flanders-Netcong Road should again be a through street to Gold Mine Road; and

WHEREAS, the Township will restrict the weight limit on Flanders-Netcong Road to preclude large vehicular traffic by placing signage as recommended by Mt. Olive Police; and

WHEREAS, the Township will repair the portion of Flanders-Netcong Road at the vacated portion and strip the road as requested by Mt. Olive Police; and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes Flanders Netcong Road to again be a through street to Gold Mine Road;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Flanders Netcong Road shall be a through street to Gold Mine Road and the 10 feet wide strip previously vacated, but title to same retained by the Township, is hereby be activated for road purposes; and

Section 2. The gates previously placed on Flanders Netcong Road shall be removed;

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effecting 30 days after final adoption and publication as well as removal of the gate.
