**Ord. #29-2011**  
**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE**  
**PROVIDING FOR SECURITY FOR AND AROUND THE**  
**POLICE DEPARTMENT FACILITY, PARKING LOTS**  
**AND EQUIPMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police has recommended that steps be taken to provide security around that portion of the Municipal Building where the Police Department is located and the adjoining parking lots wherein the “fully loaded” police cars are located and other types of police equipment is kept; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief has noted that this area is not secured and that prisoners and those under arrest generally traverse this area some times without security;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1.** Access to the area described, which area shall be defined by the Chief of Police and access through the area shall be under the specific control of the Chief of Police. Signage shall be posted defining the area to be secured and fencing may be installed.

**Section 2.** The Chief of Police shall designate those other than police officers who shall be permitted into the area. All other persons, i.e., persons not authorized to access the area shall not access the area on foot or by car except when accompanied by a police officer.


**Section 3.** Anyone who accesses the secured area shall be charged with trespass as well as any other infraction, i.e., destruction of public property, where appropriate.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with Law.
