On March 9, 2013, all homeowners affected by Superstorm Sandy will have an opportunity to meet with mortgage industry experts, housing counselors, insurance companies and other housing-related organizations at the Hope for New Jersey Event in Sayreville, NJ.

Mortgage servicers will be available to discuss mortgages and insurance as it relates to disaster relief. A HUD-approved, nonprofit housing counselor will be onsite to provide options involving disaster relief and housing assistance. A

representative from the insurance industry will go over the claims process and what it entails. A representative from the Office of the Attorney General will have a discussion on how to avoid home improvement scams.

Attendees should bring a copy of their monthly mortgage statement, information about other mortgages on your home, documentation of all income and all property insurance documents, including any adjuster damage assessments.
