

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

To Whom It May Concern:



In accordance with the Freshwater Wetlands Protection Act Rules (N.J.A.C. 7:7A-1 et. seq.), the applicant, Fratelli Beretta U.S.A., is requesting authorization for Statewide General Permit Number 6 to disturb 0.03 acre of isolated wetlands to construct an 180,000 square foot warehouse and assembly facility with associated parking and loading facilities. As required by Section 7:7A-10.2 and 10.4 of the Rules, enclosed please find the following information:

1. A completed Freshwater Wetlands General Permit Authorization Application Checklist and Fee Table.
2. A completed DLUR form.
3. A check of \$600.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of New Jersey" for the application fee.
4. A copy of the letter to the Township of Mount Olive Clerk transmitting a complete copy of the request for a General Permit and verification of the certified notice.
5. Verification that legal notification (Attachment A) has been sent to the Township of Mount Olive Clerk, Planning Board, Environmental Commission and Construction Official, the Morris County Planning Board, and property owners within 200 feet of the legal boundary line. Certified mail notices and a certified list of property owners are attached.
6. Copies of the USGS , New Jersey quadrangle, up to date local road map, and soils on-site with the site clearly indicated.
7. Copy of the tax map showing the property.
8. Color photographs showing the portion of the site that will be disturbed by the proposed activities.
9. A Statement of Compliance describing the project and proposed activities as well as a list and description of compliance of all limits and requirements at N.J.A.C. 7:7A-4.3, and 7:7A-5.6.

10. A chain of title search that details the ownership history of the site from June 30, 1988 to the present. This includes documentation of when the lot was created by subdivision and a listing of contiguous lots that were in common ownership with the site and a chain of title search for each lot since June 30, 1988.
11. A copy Wetland Data sheets documenting the soils and vegetation which formed the basis for the delineation of the isolated wetland subject of the General Permit Number 6 application.
12. A List of Licenses, Permits, and other Approvals needed for the Project which contains information regarding whether other approvals are required for the activities by Federal, interstate, State and local agencies for the activity; information regarding whether any such approvals or denials have been received; and information regarding whether the proposed activities are consistent with the rules, plans, or policies of other Federal, interstate, State and local agencies.
13. A signed statement certifying that the proposed activities will not result in any direct or indirect impacts to swamp pink/bog turtles or their documented habitat.
14. A copy of all past Department Approvals for the site, if any.
15. Five folded copies of the Wetlands Permitting plan.
