**WHEREAS**, the Boy Scouts have expressed an interest in staying overnight in Turkey Brook Park the night before the Mount Olive Memorial Day Parade; and

**WHEREAS**, the Boy Scouts have sought the permission of the Township to use Turkey Brook Park for this event; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township's Administration approves of this request.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that the Boy Scouts shall be permitted to stay overnight in Turkey Brook Park on May 25, 2014.
