**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive that it does hereby certify that the matching funds of up to \$30,000.00 is available to this project from the Open Space Trust Fund as required by the Morris County Preservation Trust and the application may be duly signed by the Mayor or Business Administrator.
