



**Now Available: Stronger NJ Business Grant program**

Today, the New Jersey Economic Development Authority (NJEDA) will begin accepting applications for the Stronger NJ Business Grant Program. This program provides up to \$50,000 per impacted location and up to \$250,000 per entity to eligible small businesses and non-profit organizations which sustained a minimum of \$5,000 in physical damage from Superstorm Sandy.

Governor Chris Christie has tasked the NJEDA to administer \$460 million of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding to support the recovery of storm-impacted businesses. Of this total, \$260 million will fund the Stronger NJ Business Grant program.


