

Dear Ms. DiGregorio:

On behalf of the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT), Dewberry Engineers Inc. (Dewberry) has completed remediation of environmental contamination at the NJDOT Hackettstown Maintenance Facility located at MP 23 Route 46 and Drakestown Road in Washington Township, Morris County, New Jersey. The work was conducted under rules established by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP), which has assigned it case number 96-03-04-1817-58. The remediation was prompted by the presence of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) in groundwater, and the remediation involved in-situ groundwater remediation and monitoring. The preparation of a Remedial Action Outcome (RAO) report documenting closure of the petroleum-related VOC plume to be submitted to the NJDEP is currently in progress.

During the course of the work, periodic updates about the progress were be made available to Washington Twp. and Mt. Olive officials and are available to you upon request. Should you have any questions regarding the work, you can contact me at 609-530-2257 to answer any questions you may have.

We hope the work we conducted will restore the property as a valuable asset to the neighborhood. In the meantime, we appreciate your concerns and your patience and pledge to conduct our work efficiently and as responsible members of the community.
