

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF  
MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF  
A SPECIAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER– CLASS II FOR 2013**

**WHEREAS**, Mount Olive Township Mayor Robert Greenbaum, Mount Olive School Superintendant Larrie Reynolds, Mount Olive Council President Colleen Labow and Mount Olive Township Police Chief Mark Spitzer have collaboratively identified the desire to restore an active police presence in our schools; and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Chief has identified a need for a Special Law Enforcement Officer – Class II for the year 2013, to aid in that pursuit and as such has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Mount Olive Board of Education; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mount Olive Township Police Chief was in receipt of an April 30, 2013 letter from the New Jersey Division of Criminal Justice, Police Training Commission, accepting Joseph J. Kluska’s prior 26 years of unblemished police service and granting a waiver of Special Law Enforcement – Class II Officer training; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mount Olive Police Department has completed a fingerprint check of Joseph Kluska which indicates that he has no criminal history since the April 2011 separation from the Mount Olive Police Department as a full-time police officer and meets the minimum requirements set forth in Title 40A:14-146.10 (Special Law Enforcement Officers – Class II); and

**WHEREAS**, Chief of Police Mark Spitzer has submitted Joseph J. Kluska for appointment as a Special Law Enforcement Officer – Class II for the Township of Mount Olive for the year 2013.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive that Joseph J. Kluska is hereby appointed as a Special Law Enforcement Officer – Class II for the Township of Mount Olive for the remainder of calendar year 2013, as a Board of Education salaried employee in accordance with the Memorandum of Understanding with the Mount Olive Board of Education to begin his assignment at the opening of the 2013-2014 School Year.
