


*A message from Clarence Anthony, NLC's Executive Director:*

"With the United States Senate's approval 69 to 27 tonight of the Marketplace Fairness Act and President Obama saying he will sign the legislation into law, we are two-thirds of the way to treating all retailers equally – whether on Main Street or on the internet. Next we need the House of Representatives to pass its bill (H.R. 684).

"I applaud every Senator who voted tonight for the Marketplace Fairness Act, and especially thank the bill's bipartisan leadership team of Senators Michael Enzi (R-WY), Richard Durbin (D-IL), Lamar Alexander (R-TN) and Heidi Heitkamp (D-ND). Tonight's vote has been a long time coming.

"I also thank everyone in the NLC family who asked their Senators to support the Marketplace Fairness Act. Without your help, we would not be here tonight. Now our attention shifts to the House.

"NLC calls on House Judiciary Chairman Bob Goodlatte (R-VA), whose Committee has jurisdiction, to hold a hearing on this important legislation in short order. I also ask every city official to reach out to their House members to ask them to support the Marketplace Fairness Act. We need to help Representative Steve Womack (R-AR) and the 65 co-sponsors of H.R. 684 get this bill passed."
