**WHEREAS**, the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) recently completed a traffic investigation on Route 46 in Mount Olive Township; and

**WHEREAS**, NJDOT will update existing records to reflect No Passing Zone conditions along (US)(NJ) Route 46.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, Count of Morris, in the State of New Jersey, that it supports the use of a “No Passing Zone” on Route 46 in Mount Olive Township as recommended by NJDOT.
