infrastructure adjacent to the project site on August 10, 2004, and that adequate capacity is available, with a written commitment to service the proposed project; and


- 3) The point of connection to the wastewater collection system as it existed on August 10, 2004 must be shown on the site plan.

A copy of the submittal that you send in response to this letter, as well as supporting information, must also be sent to those parties listed at N.J.A.C. 7:38-9.2(b)5.

Please be advised that you have 30 days from the date of receipt of this letter to submit the information required above. If after 30 days the required information is not submitted or fails to satisfy the deficiencies listed above, you will be issued a determination based on the information included in your current application, which may result in your application being cancelled.
