**BOND ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3(h) OF BOND
ORDINANCE #13-2012, AS AMENDED BY BOND
ORDINANCE #25-2012 AND BOND ORDINANCE #33-2012,
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE
COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, FINALLY
ADOPTED APRIL 24, 2012, AS AMENDED JULY 24, 2012
AND OCTOBER 16, 2012 IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR
THE 3 PHASE POWER AT TURKEY BROOK PARK
PROJECT**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-
thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Section 3(h) of Bond Ordinance #13-2012, as amended by Bond Ordinance #25-2012 and Bond Ordinance #33-2012, of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Township"), finally adopted April 24, 2012, as amended July 24, 2012 and October 16, 2012, is hereby amended to provide for the "3 Phase Power at Turkey Brook Park Project" in the third paragraph so that it will provide in its entirety as follows: "Improvements to rims and backboards for the Turkey Brook basketball courts and the fields, the turf soccer field and football field lighting at Turkey Brook Park, the 3 Phase Power at Turkey Brook Park Project, the acquisition of a portable emergency generator for the Senior Building and the acquisition of a sign for the Municipal Building, including all related costs and

expenditures incidental thereto and further including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.”

Section 2. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 3. This bond ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
