

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE REJECTING THE BID FROM FIRST PRIORITY EMERGENCY VEHICLES INC. FOR THE CONTRACT FOR TYPE III EMERGENCY MEDICAL VEHICLE FOR FLANDERS RESCUE

WHEREAS, the Township advertised and received one bid for the provision of a Type III Emergency Medical Vehicle for Flanders Rescue from the following vendor,

First Priority Emergency Vehicles, Inc.

\$172,897

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by First Priority Emergency Vehicles, Inc. must be rejected as the bid proposal submission failed to include an adequate and unconditional Consent of Surety which is a mandatory item and the failure to submit an adequate and unconditional Consent of Surety is a material, non-waivable and fatal defect that renders the bid proposal unresponsive pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23.2; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The bid proposal received by the Township for the Type III Emergency Medical Vehicle for Flanders Rescue is hereby rejected in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law and the reasons set forth in this Resolution.

2. The Business Administrator is hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the Township to re-advertise for bid proposal submissions for the above referenced project in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law and to return any bid bonds submitted by the vendor in accordance with the latest bid proposal submission.
