

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE
AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER TO THE CONTRACT FOR THE CLOVERHILL
WWTP INFLUENT SCREEN REPLACEMENT**

WHEREAS, the Township previously awarded a contract to STONE HILL CONTRACTING for CLOVERHILL WWTP INFLUENT SCREEN REPLACEMENT; and

WHEREAS, in connection with STONE HILL CONTRACTING work pursuant to the aforementioned contract it was determined by STONE HILL CONTRACTING that issue No 3- Influent Screen High- High Alarm and Strobe, is required and not a part of the original bid request; and

WHEREAS, STONE HILL CONTRACTING has proposed to install the aforementioned alarm system; and

WHEREAS, STONE HILL CONTRACTING has proposed to perform this work for \$2,058.00; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Memorandum, dated August 12, 2014, the Township's Business Administrator has brought the need for a change order to perform this work to the Township Council and finds the work necessary and has recommended passage of the change order in the amount of \$2,058.00; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-11.3, the change order has not caused the originally awarded contract price to be exceeded by more than 20 percent; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-11.8, the need for this change order is due to an unforeseeable problem which could not be foreseen at the time the specifications were written and the contract awarded; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-11.8, this change order constitutes a minor modification to resolve a minor problem.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, that it authorizes a written amendment to the contract with STONE HILL CONTRACTING at a total cost not to exceed \$2,058.00 as set forth in the change order proposal submitted by STONE HILL CONTRACTING.

This resolution will take effect immediately upon its passage.
