**WHEREAS**, Detective Sergeant Hyland began working for the Township of Mount Olive in August, 1989; and has unselfishly served the citizens of Mount Olive and the State of New Jersey in a manner that is beyond reproach for the last 25 years; and

**WHEREAS**, Kevin served in various roles in the Police Department, was promoted to Sergeant in 2007 where he was responsible for the supervision of a patrol squad, until his transfer to the Investigations Division where he served as a Detective Sergeant where he supervised detectives and investigative responsibilities, and

**WHEREAS**, during his tenure, Kevin was assigned to the Morris County Prosecutor's Office, Narcotics Task Force, where he served in an undercover detective capacity and was instrumental in several investigations which culminated with the arrests of illegal narcotic distribution rings that disrupted narcotic activity within Mount Olive and the County of Morris, and

**WHEREAS**, Detective Sergeant Hyland was instrumental in improving the Field Training Officer Program where he and other officers mentored newly hired officers; and developed new programs for our Police Department which included the All Community Tips (ACT) Program where concerned citizens had the ability to report crimes and tips to the police department in a fashion which maintained confidentiality for witnesses; and

**WHEREAS**, He is a caring compassionate man who has saved more lives than we will ever know through his genuine concern for people in trouble and his ability to see the good in all; and

**WHEREAS**, above and beyond Detective Sergeant Hyland dedicated service he received many awards which includes 4 Honorable Service Awards, 4 Grand Cordon Awards, 2 Program Development Awards, an Exception Duty Award, a Physical Fitness Award, a Knights of Columbus Shield Award and several Letters of Commendations, and;

**WHEREAS**, the citizens of Mount Olive Township and the members of the Mount Olive Township Police have been fortunate to have such a dedicated man serve them so well for so long.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive that they do hereby congratulate Detective Sergeant Kevin Hyland on his retirement and wish him health, happiness and fortune in his future endeavors.
