## Christie Administration Awards \$5 Million in Grants

The Christie Administration announced the award of \$5 million in grants to 64 municipalities to promote safety along designated Safe Corridor highway segments and to advance local street rehabilitation projects. A total of 56 municipalities will share \$3 million in FY 13 Safe Corridors grants and eight municipalities will share \$2.15 million in FY 13 Local Aid Infrastructure Fund (LAIF) grants. 
## The Truth About Idling a Vehicle




## Atlantic Health System: A Bike to Work Champion






## Teens Delaying Licensure-A Cause for Concern?

The majority of American teens today delay getting a driver's license, according to new study by the AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety. Less than half (44 percent) of teens surveyed obtained a driver's license within 12 months of the minimum age for licensing in their state and just over half (54 percent) became licensed before their 18th birthday, causing concern among safety experts that young adult drivers are missing the benefits intended by graduated drivers licensing (GDL). 

