

RESOLUTION _____-2014

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF CONTRACTS FOR THE PROVISION OF AUTO PARTS FOR THE MOUNT OLIVE TOWNSHIP FLEET

WHEREAS, the Township advertised and received bids for the provision, by up to three (3) vendors, of auto parts for the Mount Olive Township fleet from the following vendors,

FAMILY FORD INC.

PADIK AUTO PARTS, INC.

WHEREAS, the Township Council is satisfied with the proposals submitted by Family Ford Inc. and Padik Auto Parts, Inc., the lowest responsible bidders, as being the proposals which satisfy the best interest of the Township and being in conformance with the requirements promulgated pursuant to the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to proceed with this necessary service and for that purpose accepts the proposals submitted by Family Ford Inc. and Padik Auto Parts, Inc.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. It does hereby authorize the issuance of a contract to Padik Auto Parts, Inc., 423 Route 513, Califon, New Jersey 07830, as the primary vendor for the provision of auto parts for the Mount Olive Township fleet which contract shall specify the scope of services as set forth in Padik Auto Parts, Inc.'s proposal, at total costs and prices not to exceed those set forth in the proposal.
2. It does hereby authorize the issuance of a contract to Family Ford Inc., Netcong, New Jersey 07857, as the secondary vendor for the provision of auto parts for the Mount Olive Township fleet which contract shall specify the scope of services as set forth in Family Ford Inc.'s proposal, at total costs and prices not to exceed those set forth in the proposal.
2. The Mayor is specifically authorized to execute the aforementioned contract.

This resolution will take effect immediately upon its passage.
