

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT

AGRICULTURE GYPSY MOTH TREATMENT WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP**

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Agriculture has notified the Township that defoliation has been detected within the Township which is caused by gypsy moth; and

WHEREAS, if it is determined from egg mass surveys that aerial treatment is required, the NJ Department of Agriculture will develop spray contracts, supervise spray operations and apply for federal cost-sharing funds; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive that it does hereby support the New Jersey Department of Agriculture egg mass surveys and aerial treatment for gypsy moth if deemed necessary.
