Subject: 2014 Fall Routine Aerial Patrols on JCP&L transmission lines to begin Thursday, September 11th.

Please be advised that Haverfield will be performing Fall Routine Aerial Inspections on the JCP&L transmission lines beginning on Thursday, September 11th. The Routine Aerial Inspections in the JCP&L region typically require about 12-15 days for completion, so the aerial patrols are expected to into the last week of the month depending of course on weather conditions, as well as other scheduling needs. The helicopter will be flying slowly (20-30 mph) along the lines, and may hover at any time for a closer inspection. The helicopter scheduled for these patrols is a black with red letters, MD 500 , w/ registration (tail) number N353AH. Please see attached photo for details.

It should be noted that the contractor has been authorized to patrol the transmission circuits in their entirety (i.e. "breaker-to-breaker"), so patrols on certain lines may therefore extend into the neighboring regions. The flight crew provides information on their daily location to both Transmission Lines Maintenance and the WCC, and the pilot will be in communication with any local airports when in their airspace. Please advise local Safety Forces and other public entities or sensitive customers as needed.

Please note that poor weather and emergency patrols/repairs elsewhere may cause re-scheduling and/or delays in the projected schedule. As always, please feel free to contact me with any questions, problems, or if you are in need of any additional information regarding the Routine Aerial Inspections. Also, please forward this communication internally to anyone else as needed.
