**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE TO
REDUCE FEES FOR PHOTOCOPIES AND CD'S PURSUANT
TO SECTION 102-1, SUBSECTIONS E AND F, AND SECTION
102-5, SUBSECTION B, OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
MOUNT OLIVE**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, as follows:


SECTION 1. Section 102-1, Subsections E and F of the Code of the Township of Mount Olive is hereby amended as follows:

- E. Minutes of the meetings of the Township Council, Land Use Board, Board of Health or any other municipal agency shall be at the rate of \$0.5 per page.
- F. A recording of the meeting of the Township Council, Land Use Board, Board of Health or any other municipal agency shall be at the rate of \$1.25 per CD.

SECTION 2. Section 102-5, Subsections A and B, of the Code of the Township of Mount Olive is hereby amended as follows:

- A. The fee for the duplication of any government record embodied in the form of printed matter shall not exceed \$0.5 per page.
- B. The Township Clerk shall have the discretion to require a deposit against cost for reproducing documents sought through an anonymous request whenever the Township Clerk anticipates that the information thus requested will cost in excess of \$5 to reproduce.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.
