**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, COUNTY OF MORRIS,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 245,
VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES
SPEED LIMITS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Council of the Township of Mount Olive,
County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 245, Vehicles and Traffic, Section 245-41, Schedule II:
Speed Limits, of the aforesaid Revised General Ordinances is hereby amended to read
as follows:

§ 245-41. Schedule II: Speed Limits.

In accordance with the provisions of § 245-4, speed limits are hereby established upon
the following described streets or parts thereof:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Direction</u>	<u>Speed Limit</u>	<u>Location</u>
International Drive South	Both	35	Entire Length

SECTION 2. All ordinances of the Township of Mount Olive which are
inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of
such inconsistency.


SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for
any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court or competent jurisdiction,
such decision shall not affect the remaining portion of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance may be renumbered for purposes of codification.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage,
approval and publication as required by law.


