WHEREAS, in April of 1985, Lisa Lashway was hired as the Township Clerk obtaining her Registered Municipal Clerk's Certification in 1988; and

WHEREAS, Lisa Lashway has had a long and accomplished career as the Mount Olive Township Clerk; and

WHEREAS, in 2009, Lisa Lashway obtained certification from the State Records Committee for Mount Olive Township and took part in the Morris County Shared Services Project and was able to benefit from the PARIS Grant program offered in 2009-2010 for Image Processing of Public Records; and

WHEREAS, Lisa Lashway has always been a proponent of the Township's utilization of technology and has twice re-codified the Township Code Book first in the early 1990's and then again in 2015; and

WHEREAS, in addition to being the Township Clerk for over thirty (30) years, Lisa Lashway has also acted as the Secretary to the Lake Committee and Secretary for the Municipal Clerks Association of Morris County for the years 2008 and 2009; and

WHEREAS, Lisa Lashway played a central role in the handling of one of the first recall elections in the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Lisa Lashway was selected to be part of the committee that was involved in the roll out of the NJ Portal (State Site); and

WHEREAS, in 1991, Lisa Lashway was named Woman of the Year by the Musconetcong Lodge; and

WHEREAS, Lisa Lashway was always a hard worker and a leader while serving as the Township Clerk; and

WHEREAS, Lisa Lashway has retired from employment with the Township of Mount Olive effective October 1, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Lisa Lashway and her service will certainly be missed by the residents of Mount Olive Township; and

WHEREAS, during her over thirty (30) years of service to the Township of Mount Olive, Lisa Lashway earned the respect and admiration of her colleagues for her public service and dedication to the residents of the Township of Mount Olive; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Olive wishes Lisa Lashway the best of luck on her retirement.
