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

Columbia Gas Transmission, LLC (Columbia) is applying to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) for authorization under the Freshwater Wetlands Protection Act Rules (N.J.A.C. 7:7A), the Flood Hazard Area Control Act Rules (N.J.A.C. 7:13), and the Coastal Zone Management Rules (N.J.A.C. 7:7) to perform routine maintenance activities within regulated areas along their pipeline network in New Jersey. Specifically, Columbia is requesting a Statewide General Permit 1 pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:7A-5.1, a Flood Hazard Area Individual Permit pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:13-11.9(f), and a Waterfront Development Individual Permit pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:7. This approval, referred to as a Blanket Permit, will allow Columbia to provide for ongoing maintenance of its natural gas pipeline system in regulated waters, flood hazard areas, riparian zones, wetlands and transition areas under NJDEP jurisdiction. Columbia owns and operates approximately 69 miles of existing natural gas pipeline and associated rights-of-way (ROW), infrastructure and appurtenances located in northern and southern New Jersey in the counties of Morris, Hunterdon, Warren, and Gloucester.


