

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF THE CONTRACT FOR SNOW PLOWING SERVICES FOR ROUTE D “OUTLOOK PARK” ONLY TO SALMON BROS., INC. AND ANDY-MATT INC.**

**WHEREAS**, the Township advertised and received bids for Snowplowing Services – Route D “Outlook Park” Only from the following vendors:

**Salmon Bros., Inc.**

Operator & Minimum 10,000 lb. GVW Truck - \$120.00 per hour

Operator & Minimum 15,000 lb. GVW Truck - \$140.00 per hour

**Andy-Matt Inc.**

Operator & Minimum 10,000 lb. GVW Truck - \$121.00 per hour

Operator & Minimum 15,000 lb. GVW Truck - \$139.00 per hour

**WHEREAS**, the bid specifications require one of each type of truck for Route D; and

**WHEREAS**, the combined hourly rate of both bids received from Salmon Bros., Inc. (\$120.00 per hour for the 10,000 lb. GVW Truck and \$140.00 per hour for the 15,000 lb. GVW Truck) and Andy Matt Inc. (\$121.00 per hour for the 10,000 lb. GVW Truck and \$139.00 per hour for the 15,000 lb. GVW Truck) both total \$240.00 per hour; and

**WHEREAS**, this means that there is tie between Salmon Bros., Inc. and Andy Matt Inc. for the lowest bid; and

**WHEREAS**, because of the tie, the Township believes that it is in the best interests of the Township to award a contract to both bidders to the extent needed at the discretion of the Township’s Business Administrator; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township wishes to proceed with this necessary service and for that purpose accepts the proposals submitted by Salmon Bros., Inc. and Andy- Matt Inc.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. It does hereby authorize the issuance of contracts to Salmon Bros., Inc. and Andy Matt Inc. for the provision of Snowplowing Services – Route D “Outlook Park” Only to the extent needed at the discretion of the Township’s Business Administrator, which contracts shall specify the scope of services as set forth in Salmon Bros., Inc.’s proposal and Andy-Matt Inc.’s proposal, at a total cost not to exceed the above prices as set forth in the proposals.
2. The Mayor is specifically authorized to execute the aforementioned contracts.
