

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT
OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A MEMORANDUM OF
UNDERSTANDING WITH THE NEW JERSEY STATE POLICE VOLUNTEER
REVIEW OPERATION**

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Olive has recently adopted a Background Check Ordinance applicable to employees and volunteers that will be supervising minors in the Township; and

WHEREAS, in order to implement the ordinance in particular the requirement that fingerprint background checks be conducted by the State Bureau of Identification of the New Jersey State Police it is necessary that Mount Olive Recreation Department register with the Volunteer Review Operation as a governmental Youth Serving Organization; and

WHEREAS, as part of this registration process, the Mount Olive Recreation Department must enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Volunteer Review Operation regarding the responsibilities of the Youth Serving Organization, including, but not limited to maintenance of status as a nonprofit organization and as being a tax exempt organization.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Mount Olive Township Council hereby approves the Memorandum of Understanding by and between the Mount Olive Recreation Department and the Volunteer Review Operation, attached to this Resolution and made a part hereof, allowing the Mount Olive Recreation Department to register with the Volunteer Review Operation as a governmental Youth Serving Organization in order that background checks be conducted by the State Bureau of Identification of the New Jersey State Police.
2. The Mount Olive Township Council hereby authorizes Jill Daggon, Recreation Supervisor, to execute, on behalf of the Township, the Memorandum of Understanding by and between the Mount Olive Recreation Department and the Volunteer Review Operation.

This resolution will take effect immediately upon its passage.
