

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP TO ABATE CERTAIN NUISANCE PROPERTIES LOCATED AT BLOCK 5001 LOT 11 (310 FLANDERS-NETCONG ROAD) & BLOCK 5000 LOT 6 (150 ROUTE 206)**

**WHEREAS**, the owners of the following properties have failed to maintain the exterior of their property creating a nuisance in violation of Mount Olive Township Code Section 185-39; and

**BLOCK 5001 LOT 11 (310 Flanders-Netcong Road)  
BLOCK 5000 LOT 6 (150 Route 206)**

**WHEREAS**, based upon such nuisance being created by the aforementioned properties owners a notice of violation and order of abatement was issued by the Township of Mount Olive Zoning Officer, which such citations being mailed to the owners via regular mail, certified mail and a notice being posted conspicuously at the above mentioned properties; and

**WHEREAS**, the property owners of the above referenced properties have failed to respond to the notices of violation in order to abate the nuisances issues and have taken no steps to maintain the exterior of said premises; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Mount Olive is desirous of abating the nuisances locate at the exterior of the above referenced properties.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey does hereby authorize the Township and specifically the Township Department of Public Works to abate the nuisances located at the exterior of the premises located at the above references properties; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Township of Mount Olives costs associated with the abatement of this nuisance shall be certified to the Township Tax Assessor and Tax Collector and shall become part of the taxes next assessed against the subject premises pursuant to section 185-42 (a)(5) of Township Code.
