

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT
OLIVE CONSENTING TO THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE UPPER
DELAWARE WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Town of Hackettstown desires to provide for the orderly development of wastewater facilities within Hackettstown, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) requires that proposed wastewater treatment and conveyance facilities and wastewater treatment service areas, as well as related subjects, be in conformance with an approved water quality management plan; and

WHEREAS, the NJDEP has established the water quality management plan amendment procedure as the method of incorporating unplanned facilities into a water quality management plan; and

WHEREAS, a proposed water quality management plan amendment noticed in the New Jersey Register on October 19, 2015 for the Upper Delaware Water Quality Management Plan has been prepared by the New Jersey Highlands Council.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Township of Mount Olive hereby consents to the proposed amendment to the Upper Delaware Water Quality Management Plan, and publicly noticed on October 19, 2015, prepared by the New Jersey Highlands Council, for the purpose of its incorporation into the applicable water quality management plan.
2. This consent shall be submitted to the NJDEP in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4.

This resolution will take effect immediately upon its passage.
