

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT
OLIVE REJECTING THE PROPOSAL FROM MCCAFFERTY
ENTERPRISES, CO. INC. FOR CARNIVAL SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Township advertised and received one bid for the provision of carnival services from the following vendor as follows,

McCafferty Enterprises, Co. Inc.

WHEREAS, the proposal submitted by McCafferty Enterprises, Co. Inc. must be rejected as it failed to include a proposal guarantee of bid bond which was required by the specifications and which is a mandatory item which failure to submit is a material, non-waivable and fatal defect that renders the proposal unresponsive pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23.2; and

WHEREAS, the proposal submitted by McCafferty Enterprises, Co. Inc. must be rejected as it failed to include a consent of surety which was required by the specifications and which is a mandatory item which failure to submit is a material, non-waivable and fatal defect that renders the proposal unresponsive pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23.2.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The bid proposal received by the Township for the provision of carnival services is hereby rejected in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law and the reasons set forth in this Resolution.
2. The Township Clerk is hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the Township to re-advertise for proposal submissions for the above referenced project in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law.

This resolution will take effect immediately upon its passage.
