

Scope of the Permit

This Permit, along with the referenced application documents herein specified, shall constitute the sole approval of solid waste facility operations for **MORRIS COUNTY MUA - MOUNT OLIVE TS** located in the Township of Mount Olive, Morris County, New Jersey. Any registration, approval or permit previously issued by the Division of Solid & Hazardous Waste, or its predecessor agencies, for the specific activities described below and as conditioned herein, is hereby superseded.

Facility Description

The facility is a commercial solid waste transfer station facility owned by the Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority (MCMUA) and operated by Solid Waste Services d/b/a J. P. Mascaro & Sons (Mascaro) through a contract with the MCMUA. The facility is located at 168 Gold Mine Road, Mount Olive Township, Morris County. Although the site is a 17.6 acre parcel of property described as Block 4500, Lot 5, actual operations related to the solid waste facility are limited to 9.3 acres of that property. Additionally, the MCMUA can stage up to 12 empty transfer trailers on MCMUA property identified as Block 4500, Lot 4.

The permittee is authorized to accept, within the transfer station building, solid waste types ID 10 (Municipal Waste); ID 13 (Bulky Waste); ID 13C (Construction and Demolition Waste); ID 23 (Vegetative Waste); ID 25 (Animal and Food Processing Waste); and ID 27 (Dry Industrial Waste) (excluding Asbestos and Asbestos Containing Waste) for processing and transfer, Monday through Saturday at a maximum rate of 975 tons per day. Source separated recyclable materials may not be accepted, but ferrous metal detected in delivered solid waste material may be recovered. Waste is accepted 7:00 AM to 4:30 PM Monday through Friday and 7:00 AM to 1:00 PM on Saturday. Exempt vehicles (less than 9000 pounds gross vehicular weight (GVW); exempt at N.J.A.C. 7:26-3.3) are accepted during all operating hours. Waste is processed 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM Monday through Friday and 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM on Saturday.

MCMUA has designated an area outside of the west wall of the transfer station building to accept small vehicles, which are either manually unloaded or exempted from the solid waste registration requirements. The unloading of solid waste in this area is monitored at all times by either MCMUA officials or Mascaro personnel to provide instruction and to ensure the safety of the operation. Bay 4 of the transfer station building can also be used during off peak hours.

The transfer station building is equipped with a dry overhead sprinkler system for fire control. Additional fire control equipment includes hand held fire extinguishers located at various locations on the tipping floor.

It should be noted that the approved O and M Manual contains references to an approved contingency plan. The contingency plan currently approved by the Department involves either the diversion of solid waste to the MCMUA's Par-Troy TS/MRF (if capacity limits of that facility allow it) or requesting the transporter to deliver waste the next day.

SUMMARY

A transfer station facility is defined in N.J.A.C. 7:26-1.4 as a solid waste facility that transfers solid waste from one solid waste vehicle to another solid waste vehicle for transport to an authorized solid waste facility.

On February 11, 2015 the Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority (MCMUA) submitted an application to renew its solid waste facility permit with no changes to the facility operations or capacity. The facility is permitted to accept a maximum of 975 tons of solid waste on a daily basis. On March 23, 2015 the application was deemed administratively incomplete and the applicant was requested to submit additional information to make the application complete. On March 31, 2015 the applicant submitted the additional information and on April 17, 2015 the application was deemed administratively complete. On July 29, 2015 the Bureau sent a notification to the applicant indicating that the application was technically complete.

The MCMUA facility is a county owned solid waste transfer facility that is located on Gold Mine Road, slightly west of the intersection of that road and US Route 206 in Mount Olive Township. Although the site is a 17.6 acre parcel of property described as Block 4500, Lot 5, actual operations related to the solid waste facility is limited to 9.3 acres of the property. The operation of the transfer station/materials recovery facility is through a contract with Solid Waste Services, Inc. d/b/a Mascaro & Sons. However, the weigh station and all of its operations are under the control of the MCMUA.

The Permittee is seeking to obtain a SWF Permit renewal from the Department with no changes to its permitted capacity or operations as indicated above. The duration of the renewed Permit will be for a maximum period of five years.

Environmental Considerations

The facility will continue to accept the following solid waste types: ID 10 Municipal Waste; ID 13 Bulky Waste; ID 13C Construction and Demolition Debris; ID 23 Vegetative Waste; ID 25 Animal and Food Processing Waste; and ID 27 Dry Industrial. Limited recovery of ferrous metals detected in the solid waste stream is permitted and occurs within the transfer building. The facility is allowed to accept and process a maximum of 975 tons of solid waste per day (Monday through Saturday). Hours of waste acceptance are from 7:00 AM to 4:30 PM Monday through Friday and 7:00 AM to 1:00 PM Saturdays. Hours of waste processing are from 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM Monday through Friday and 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM Saturday. All solid waste and recovered metals must be removed from the transfer station building by the end of the approved processing day.

MCMUA has designated an area outside of the west wall of the transfer station building to accept small vehicles, which are either manually unloaded or exempted from the solid waste registration requirements. The unloading of solid waste in this area is monitored at all times by either MCMUA officials or Mascaro & Sons personnel to provide instruction and to ensure the safety of the operation. Bay 4 of the transfer station building can also be used during off peak hours.

Collection vehicles enter the site from Gold Mine Road, using the Northeast entrance and make a right turn to the collection vehicle staging area. From there, the vehicles proceed to the west side of the facility to the inbound scale for weighing. After weighing the vehicles will be directed to one of four bays in the transfer station building to tip their loads. Collection vehicles will then retrace their route around the facility to be weighed on the outbound scale and exit the site to Gold Mine Road using the Northwest entrance. Prior to leaving the site, solid waste vehicles will travel over rumble strips to clean solid waste from their tires.

Transfer trailers enter the site from Gold Mine Road, using the Northwest entrance and proceed over the inbound scale. They proceed around to the north side of the facility, where they can either enter the transfer station building through an underground tunnel to one of two loading bays or be dropped in the transfer vehicle staging area. Tarping of transfer trailers occurs within the underground tunnel. Once loaded the transfer trailers will leave the transfer station building and either proceed to the outbound scale for weighing or be dropped in the outbound transfer trailer staging area.

On February 24, 2015 MCMUA conducted a traffic count at the intersection of International Drive/Route 206 and at US Route 206/Gold Mine Rd. These counts were compared with the traffic counts utilized by the NJ Department of Transportation projections for 2005 at the same intersections and were found to be well below their projections.

Because the solid waste facility is located in a portion of Mount Olive Township that does not have a sewerage system, all wastewater generated from the solid waste operations is directed via trench drains to a 6,000 gallon fiberglass tank located in the area of the Household Hazardous Waste/Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator (HHW/CESQG) facility. This tank is pumped out weekly and the wastewater is transported via tanker truck to a sewage treatment plant. All sanitary waste is directed to one of two septic tanks located on the south side of the transfer station building. The effluent from the septic tanks is discharged to a leach field. Stormwater is managed by directing the water to a detection basin located in the southwestern corner of the site.

The MCMUA Mount Olive facility has an air permit (PCP050001), with particulate control that includes sixteen prefilters and sixteen afterfilters. The prefilters must be changed every two months, while the afterfilters must be changed every six months. In addition, MCMUA uses a misting system in the transfer station building for the control of fugitive dust.

A noise study performed at the site for permit renewal showed that the facility complies with the state noise code requirements for the hours of facility operation.

Collection vehicles and/or transfer trailers accessing or exiting the facility are not allowed to park or queue on any public road. All truck maneuvering and staging occur within the limits of the facility's property.

CONCLUSIONS

The Department has completed a review of the updated Engineering Design Report, the updated Environmental and Health Impact Statement, the Operations and Maintenance (O and M) manual, the Engineering Drawings and other supplementary information submitted regarding the operation of the facility. Evaluations of the traffic, noise, air and other potential environmental impacts have demonstrated that the facility can satisfy the regulatory requirements to operate the facility by maintaining compliance with the conditions of the draft permit tentatively approved by the Department.
