

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT TO EM ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS, LLC FOR THE 350KW DIESEL GENERATOR & INSTALLATION AT MOUNT OLIVE MUNICIPAL BUILDING

WHEREAS, there exists a need for a 350kW Diesel Generator & Installation at the Mt. Olive Municipal Building; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Olive received sealed competitive bids for the 350kW Diesel Generator & Installation on October 20, 2016 at 10:30 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Olive received eleven (11) bids for the contract as follows:

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law requires that competitive bidding contracts be awarded to the lowest, responsible, responsive bidder; and

WHEREAS, following review by the Township’s professionals, the bid received from the low bidder EM Electrical Contractors LLC in the amount of \$168,900 has been found to be in proper form and in compliance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23.5 and the specifications as written; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has provided a certification that the funds for this purchase are available; and

WHEREAS, this contract has been advertised and awarded on a “fair and open basis” and nothing further shall be required under the Pay-to-Play legislation (N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.7).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mount Olive Township Council, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The Township of Mount Olive hereby awards a contract to EM Electrical Contractors LLC, 80 Merriam Avenue, Newton, NJ 07860 for the 350kW Diesel Generator & Installation at the Mt. Olive Municipal Building in the total amount of \$168,900.
