

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING PURCHASES WITH TRIAD AS A PROPRIETARY VENDOR IN ACCORDANCE WITH NJSA 40A:11-2**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Mount Olive uses access and video security software and hardware installed and maintained by Triad; and

**WHEREAS**, in accord with the precepts of the definitions of proprietary and necessary for the conduct of the Township's affairs it is in the interest of the public safety and health and welfare to maintain a security level at the municipal complex; and

**WHEREAS**, the hardware components installed and maintained cannot be readily serviced by another vendor selected through the tenets of the local public contracts law; and

**WHEREAS**, the proprietary software is limited to the unique computer design and language characteristics as supplied by Triad for their hardware; and

**WHEREAS**, the Local Public Contracts Law (NJSA 40A:11-2), and the New Jersey Administrative Code (NJAC 5:34) outline the process of defining a good or service as proprietary; and

**WHEREAS**, Triad has met the burden of finding their software to operate the hardware installed within the municipal complex as that of proprietary.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive that it does hereby authorize purchases with Triad as a proprietary vendor in accordance with NJSA 40A:11-2.
