

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT
OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE REJECTION OF ALL BIDS FOR WOODCHIP &
VEGETATIVE DEBRIS PICK-UP SERVICES**

WHEREAS, Department of Public Works is in need of a contractor to pick-up woodchip and vegetative debris; and

WHEREAS, two (2) sealed bids were received and opened on November 29, 2016 in accordance with the advertised date for acceptance of bids; and

WHEREAS, the sealed proposal did not include a Public Disclosure Statement, which is mandatory pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23.2(c); and

WHEREAS, the Public Disclosure Statement was omitted from the bid packet; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, specifically N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13.2, authorizes a municipality to reject all bids for the above-stated reason.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, that all bids received for a Woodchip & Vegetative Debris Pick-Up Services be and are hereby rejected for the reasons stated in this Resolution.
