

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE REQUESTING MORRIS COUNTY APPROVE DELAYED GREEN TRAFFIC LIGHTS AT THE INTERSECTION OF FLANDERS-NETCONG ROAD/MAIN STREET AND ROUTE 206**

**WHEREAS**, the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Mount Olive are matters of paramount importance to the Township Council; and

**WHEREAS**, serious and dangerous traffic congestion develops at the intersection of Flanders-Netcong Road/Main Street and Route 206; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mount Olive Police Department conducted a traffic study at the intersection; and

**WHEREAS**, the study concluded that there are significant traffic backups on Flanders-Netcong Road during morning rush hour, and on Main Street during evening rush hour; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the recommendation of the Mount Olive Police Department that the traffic signal at that intersection be programmed for a delayed green light, allowing automobiles on Flanders-Netcong Road to proceed first in the mornings, and automobiles on Main Street to proceed first in the evenings; and

**WHEREAS**, it would be beneficial to Mount Olive residents, as well as Morris County residents who travel this route, to have this traffic light re-programmed.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that it is formally requesting Morris County approve this request so that the Township can make same request to the State of New Jersey.
