

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF COMPLETION OF THE CONTRACT FOR COATING OF THE 1.0 MG TINC FARM WATER STORAGE TANK AWARDED TO U.S. TANK PAINTING, INC.**

**WHEREAS**, the Township advertised and received bids for coating of the 1.0 MG Tinc Farm Water Storage Tank and awarded the contract to lowest responsible bidder U.S. Tank Painting, Inc.

**WHEREAS**, the contract documents require that the project be substantially complete within ninety (90) days after the Notice to Proceed is issued , with final completion no later than one hundred and twenty (120) days after issuance of the Notice to Proceed; and

**WHEREAS**, as of February 15, 2016 the Notice to Proceed has not been issued; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Council has been advised by U.S. Tank Painting, Inc. that due to the inclement weather expected throughout the winter months and the effect same would have on application of the coating, that completion would be more feasible by June 30, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township wishes to ensure that the coating applied in accordance with the contract documents by U.S. Tank Painting, Inc. is done so in a manner to ensure proper application and longevity of the coating.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. It does hereby authorize the extension of the completion date under the contract awarded to U.S. Tank Painting, Inc. for the provision of Coating of the 1.0 MG Tinc Farm Water Storage Tank as follows:

Substantial completion no later than May 30, 2016

Final completion no later than June 30, 2016

2. The scope of services as set forth in U.S. Tank Painting, Inc.'s proposal, at a total cost not to exceed \$646,900.00 as set forth in the proposal, shall remain unchanged.

This resolution will take effect immediately upon its passage.
