On the Watershed Watchdog Front

The **Open Space Implementation bill** vetoed last month by Governor Chris Christie has been unanimously approved by a state Senate committee and is expected to be approved by Senate vote soon. If approved, the bill would implement the funding voters approved in 2014 for Green Acres farmland and preservation programs. Stay tuned!

In breaking news, we report another event in the tragic history of the **Fenimore dump in Roxbury**. Its operator has been indicted, and we thank the Grand Jury for returning its decision. RHA continues to work with the residents of Roxbury and state and federal officials to address water pollution originating from Fenimore.


